Are you wanting to do a training course for your career but need financial help to cover the costs?

You may be eligible for the Commonwealth Scholarships Program for Young Australians if you are:

- aged 15 to 24 years; or
- recently exited from the Australian Defence Force (no age restriction); and
- not in full-time work or at school at the time of applying; and
- living in one of the nominated regional areas in QLD, NT, TAS, SA, NSW, VICTORIA and WA*; and
- have applied or are intending to apply for an eligible Vocational Education and Training (VET) qualification at the Certificate III to Advanced Diploma level; and
- studying a course which leads to an eligible occupation.

Scholarship priority is given to ex-defence force personnel or young people who are Indigenous, have a disability or are from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

If eligible you could access up to \$5,000 a year of Study Assistance as well as up to \$3,000 for a 20-day internship/work placement as part of your qualification.

* Regional areas include: (NSW) Grafton and Gosford, (NT) Alice Springs, (QLD) Maryborough and Townsville, (SA) Port Pirie, (TAS) Burnie, (VIC) Shepparton, or (WA) Wanneroo and Armadale.
