We operate two youth spaces called the Junctions; one in Devonport and one in Burnie. At the Junctions we provide a range of programs, groups and information relevant for young people.

Activities regularly on offer include:

- Arvos at the Burnie Junction Wednesdays 3-5pm

Arvos is for 12-25 year olds and runs during the school terms.

School Holiday Programs run for high school aged young people in all four school holiday breaks.

We also offer Health Promotion and Education programs to young people in schools, colleges and other settings.
