The purpose of findhelptas.org.au

findhelptas.org.au aims to provide a wide ranging, publicly accessible, independently managed database of Tasmania's social services.

It is for the use of the general public and to assist those working in and with the sector to access an up-todate listing of available services.

TasCOSS and the partnership organisations maintain the findhelptas.org.au database and reserve the right to publish, or not publish, listings to ensure the database fulfills its purpose.

To make the database as broad and inclusive as possible, it is not limited to organisations and services associated with TasCOSS, its member organisations or those of the partnership.

A listing within the register does not represent endorsement, recommendation or promotion of the organisation or service by TasCOSS or the partnership organisations.

Users of findhelptas.org.au should not rely solely on the information provided and must make their own enquiries, inspections and assessments as to the suitability and quality of services.

Types of Organisations listed

The directory includes Government, statutory, regional, other bodies and establishments providing services to the community.

To be eligible to be registered within this directory, your organisation must:

- provide support services to Tasmanian communities;
- provide services that seek to benefit Tasmanian communities and increase the health and wellbeing of Tasmanians;
- provide services that are accessible to people in the community;
- not have any disqualifying purposes, examples include but are not restricted to:
 o engaging in or promoting unlawful activities,
 - o being a political party, or promoting or opposing a political party,
 - o engaging in activities that are contrary to the purposes of this directory;
- not impersonate or misrepresent an affiliation with an organisation, service or business being listed.

We reserve the right to include or exclude listings at our discretion with the intent of best supporting the goals of findhelptas.org.au, this includes consideration of broader range of listings for rural and remote areas where services are often limited.

TasCOSS and the collective partnership established to oversee management of the website are not liable for any business losses, loss of revenue, income, profits or anticipated savings, loss of contracts or business relationships, loss of reputation or goodwill, or loss or corruption of information or data associated with listing on findhelptas.org.au.

Suitable information to be listed

Information in the directory is restricted to the fields provided in the program listing form.

It is the responsibility of the organisation submitting information to:

- represent their organisation accurately and make all effort not to misrepresent an affiliation with any other organisation or service listing in the directory.
- exclude telephone numbers listed on the Commonwealth Do-Not-Call Register;
- have the necessary rights, including copyright, to the content, images and other information submitted

Content conditions

Content in directory listings must comply with the following conditions:

- Text fields will be plain text only, with no hidden code or HTML.
- Information must not be defamatory, threatening, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, unlawful, obscene, offensive, profane or indecent.
- The rights of other organisations listed in the findhelptas.org.au website must be respected.
- Duplicate listings for services and organisations will be deleted.

Process for new listings

All new listing submissions to the directory are made using the Add a Program form and must include all required information before being considered. New and updated programs are reviewed by the findhelptas.org.au administrator and may be edited for spelling, grammar and accuracy of information.

If the administrator is uncertain about the suitability of a listing, it will be referred to the partnership committee for review, who will evaluate the submission for suitability based on the service's purpose as stated above. The submitter will be notified of the decision of the partnership committee.


The administrator will contact the submitter to verify any significant changes to content before inclusion or to notify them that their submission has been unsuccessful.

Process for reviewing and updating listings

Listing organisations agree to an annual check of their listings and organisational information.

Organisations can login at any time to update their information. All changes are checked by the findhelptas.org.au administrator prior to posting.

If it is brought to the attention of findhelptas.org.au that information is out of date, the site administrator contacts the organisation to provide an update.

Process for deleting listing

Organisations can login and remove program listings at any time.

If it comes to the attention of findhelptas.org.au that an organisation or service is no longer available, the organisation is contacted to follow up.

The findhelptas.org.au administrator has the right to remove listings as deemed necessary by the partnership group, if corrective action by the listing organisations has been unsatisfactory.
